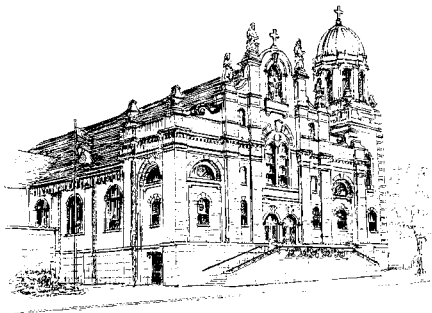

Dear Parish Family,

This is the day the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad in it, Alleluia! This beautiful antiphon taken from Psalm 118 is one we sing today with great joy as we celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord. In fact, Easter is such a wonderful event that we celebrate it for an entire octave. This is God's supreme work, for in the Resurrection Jesus not only lives again, He lives forever! The resurrected and glorified body of our Lord is no longer subject to decay, to pain, to suffering, or to the physical laws of time and space.

What a great joy and consolation that is for us, who continue our journey of faith. We know that Jesus, who took on our human nature at the Incarnation, today glorifies that nature in the Resurrection, an event that changes humankind forever. Because for us, it means that we, too, may one day share in that Resurrection. In Eucharistic Prayer III, we acknowledge that in the Resurrection, "Christ will raise our mortal bodies and make them like his own in glory." This gives us great hope amidst the difficulties we encounter in our world.

Yet, the Resurrection is more than something we simply commemorate today. It is a reality that hopefully changes the way we live today and every day. As we renew our baptismal promises, it reminds us of our pledge to live as Easter people. That calls us to boldly proclaim the Risen Christ to a waiting world in all of our actions and speech. That calls us to live without fear and have total and complete faith in God who raised Jesus from the dead. When we do this, we live in God's peace, which the world cannot give us. That peace allows us to remain calm and joyful at all times of our lives, even when storms rage around us.

As we celebrate with family and friends this day and week enjoying our particular family traditions, may these celebrations remind us that we are people of the Resurrection. May the special foods we prepare and share remind of us of God's abundant blessings. Like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, may our hearts burn with love for the Risen Lord as we recognize His Presence in one another.

It has been a great grace and joy for me to have journeyed with you during this first Lent as pastor and to share with you the joy of the Resurrection. As we have all undergone conversion through entering into the Paschal Mystery of Christ, may we continue to grow in our love for the Lord and for one another as we witness to our faith as a parish family of Holy Rosary. May our Blessed Mother, the first to share in the Resurrection of her Divine Son, continue to intercede for us and keep us always in her maternal protection.

I wish you all a most blessed Easter Day and season!

**Novena to Divine Mercy and Divine Mercy Sunday**

The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday and will conclude on Divine Mercy Sunday, May 1st. Copies of the Novena are in the pamphlet racks in the church. Through St. Faustina, our blessed Lord requested that the Sunday after Easter be officially established as the Feast of Mercy: "On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I will pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy" (from the diary of St. Faustina, 699). The Sacraments of Penance and Eucharist are special fountains of mercy which should be received as a condition for obtaining His promise for the Feast of Mercy.


